Time to Check Your Batteries!

It's time to check the fluid in your golf cart batteries. This is mainly for electric golf carts but it is a good idea for gas powered carts too. Charging batteries with low fluid is extremely dangerous!

Fill with distilled water to just above the lead plates in each cell of every battery. FILL WITH CAUTION--do not charge while opening batteries. Do not over fill and be careful not to splash in your eyes, skin and for some of you, keep chenille and chiffon fabrics away from battery acid as it will eat through all of the above. Always charge your cart overnight after adding fluid to batteries.
