Closing Up Your Site

Some things to remember when closing up this year! Please remember to disconnect your water and stow your hoses. Disconnect all power as well. If you tarp your trailer make sure that the tarp is well secured. Without fail, every year by the end of the week that camp closes at least one tarp has blown off a trailer. Make sure all waste valves are closed (black water and grey water). If you have an on demand hot water heater make sure it is blown out. If you have a golf cart, remove the battery (ies) and bring it home with you to avoid freezing. If there is gas in the tank add fuel stabilizer to it. If you are having your trailer winterized, make sure that there is clear access to the door so that the contractor can get into the trailer to complete the winterization!
